Driver Education at Whitko Jr/Sr High School

1. Students must be **15** years old to begin the class.
2. Students are required to complete **30 hours** of classroom and **6 hours** of driving with an instructor. Students who complete both requirements may apply for their license at 16 years and 90 days old.
3. Whitko will offer the traditional classroom June 7-18, 2021.

Online Course

1. Search the web at “mybmv.in.gov”, click on permits, then Driver Education, then scroll down to Licensed Driver Training schools. The schools listed in blue are the approved online providers.
2. Once a student completes and passes an online course, he/she will receive a certificate showing completion.
3. Bring the certificate of completion, the attached application with the “Driving Only” option marked and either partial or full payment to the Jr/Sr high school office.
4. The student will receive a CDE form from a school official. This document along with your online course certificate of completion must be taken to the BMV to obtain your Learner’s Permit.

Whitko Driver Education Traditional Classroom

1. To enroll in the traditional classroom, complete the registration form on page two. Return the form along with payment to Whitko Jr/Sr High School.
2. Traditional classroom students will receive a CDE form from your classroom instructor in the first few days of class. The CDE must be taken to the BMV to obtain your Learner’s Permit.

Getting Your Learner’s Permit

1. Complete the classroom requirements. Students must earn a B- or better to pass the class.
2. Take the following forms to the BMV: CDE Form (issued by school official), Certificate of Classroom Completion (online students only), Social Security Card, Birth Certificate and 2 documents proving residency.
3. A list of approved documents will be provided.
4. Pass a vision test and written test at the BMV.
5. Students will then work with an instructor for scheduling drive times.

Cost of Driver Education

1. The price for the traditional classroom/driving is \$250.
2. Online students: The fee for “driving only” is \$200. The cost of your online classroom is your responsibility and depends on your choice of provider.
3. Fees may be paid in full or in two installments. It is also possible to pay \$50.00 to enroll and then \$50.00 a month. All fees should be paid in full before the conclusion of the student’s driving portion with the instructor. Student’s completion certificate will not be signed until all fees are paid in full.
4. Make checks payable to Whitko Jr/Sr High School.
